What This Is

The Onsite Partnership Assessment is an invitation-based experience. When an organization, conference, retreat host, or impact-driven team reaches out to Plant the Seed — expressing interest in being considered as a partner, collaborator, or platform for their work — this is the process that follows.

We don't take on partnerships lightly. Before anything moves forward, we want to see the work, meet the people, and feel the culture firsthand. This assessment is how we determine whether a partnership is the right fit — for both sides.

Step One — The Initial Meeting

Complimentary. No commitment required.

Before any onsite visit is scheduled, we begin with a complimentary introductory meeting — a conversation to understand who you are, what you're building, and what you're hoping a partnership with Plant the Seed could make possible. This meeting is our way of listening first.

If there is genuine alignment, we will move forward to schedule the Onsite Partnership Assessment.

Step Two — The Onsite Assessment

Once invited to move forward, Scarlett and her team will visit your location for a dedicated, in-person assessment. This is not a pitch. It is a landscape read — a thoughtful, grounded look at your culture, your capacity, and what becomes possible when the right partnership takes root.

What the Assessment Includes

Live Experience Observation

Scarlett attends your summit, masterclass, or live event as a quiet observer — watching how you teach, how you hold a room, and how your team moves both on and off the stage. She is paying close attention to how you engage your audience, the natural flow between your team members, the genuine dynamics within your team, and whether the energy behind the scenes matches what you present to the world. She is looking at compatibility — with your own people, and with Plant the Seed. Authenticity is our foundation.

Alignment Evaluation

We assess how your goals intersect with Plant the Seed's programs, workshops, and speaking offerings — and whether there is a real, resonant fit.

Custom Recommendations

Following the assessment, you will receive a tailored proposal outlining partnership options, formats, and next steps designed specifically for your team.

Who Should Reach Out

Travel Requirements

Travel is covered through a flat rate confirmed at the time the assessment is scheduled. Scarlett's team books all travel directly upon receipt of the travel fee.
